

II. EB-2 SECOND PREFERENCE – EMPLOYMENT BASED IMMIGRATION

The Second Preference Employment Based is apportioned about 40,000 annual visas plus any of the unused visas in the First Preference Employment Based. Labor Certification (PERM) and a specific job offer are needed for most individuals in the Second Preference Employment Based category. To be exempted from the Labor Certification (PERM) and specific job offer requirement, you must request a National Interest Waiver and USCIS must be able to establish the said exemption would be in the National Interest. The Second Preference Employment Based Immigration EB-2 (Green Card) is available for the following individuals: (a) Advance Degree Professional; and (b) Exceptional Ability Worker.
